A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWESTERN INDIANA REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION AMENDING THE FY'87 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, northwest Indiana's citizenry requires a safe, efficient, effective, resource-conserving regional transportation system to attain and maintain socially, economically and environmentally sound living conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Northwestern Indiana Regional Planning Commission, hereafter referred to as The Commission, being designated the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Lake, Porter and LaPorte County Region, has established a regional, comprehensive planning program to develop the planning unified work program, short and long-range transportation plans, long-range transportation program and transportation improvement program; to annually endorse the plans and programs; to facilitate federal funding for communities and to provide technical assistance and expertise to localities; and

WHEREAS, the requested changes are generally consistent with regional plans, programs and other projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commission officially amends the FY'87 Transportation Improvement Program and Annual Element to include the state-initiated project for the replacement of the bridge on US-41 over the Little Calumet River. This resolution also amends the "A List" of projects that are earmarked for the use of Urban System Funds. This program is subject to amendment during any or all fiscal years.

Dear Mr. Gardner,

lt is our intention to meet with a private contractor regarding the removal of the Taft Street Culverts. We hope to have this accomplished within a month.

Regarding the reconstruction of Bridge No. 235, it is our intention to hire a consultant, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and the Lake County Council as soon as funding becomes available. According to a letter received from Richard F. Carlson, Chief, Planning Division, Chicago District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, we should have reconstruction completed or underway by 1995 or sooner dependent on funding.

At this time, we feel that this time schedule can be accomplished with a preliminary Engineering Agreement by 1989, dependent on funding.

At the meeting of the Little Calumet River Basin Commission on June 24, 1987, it was mentioned that the Little Calumet River Basin Commission could possibly share the consultant fee for preliminary Engineering on a 50/50 basis.





Dear Col. Franco:

The Little Calumet River Basin Development Commission, the non-Federal project sponsor with the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers on the Burns Waterway Breakwaters and Small Boat Harbor Project, Indiana, has written several letters, most recently December 11, 1986, attempting to initiate closure of our contractural obligations with respect to the above mentioned project. Copies of pertinent correspondence is enclosed.

The Commission board has directed me to again reiterate our position that a final payment was made on November 10, 1986 in the amount of \$89,172.00 to rectify damage caused to the breakwater structure and to complete dredging of the harbor, which fulfilled the Commission contractural commitment. The continued open ended nature of the contract greatly disturbs the board, which it feels can only lead to further problem situations. What was projected to be completed in a year and one half construction has dragged on for some three years and we feel this situation must reach closure.

The only recourse the Commission feels is open to them is to enlist the aid of our Federal Senators and Congressman to bring this matter to a head. Please inform us as to your position regarding this contract closure. Representatives of our Board can meet with you to discuss our concerns. If we do not hear from you by August 31 we will forward this to our Federal representatives.

I cannot emphasize enough the need for this to be a top priority item. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

This letter is to confirm our telephone conversation regarding our bridge replacement project on US 41 and I-80. The following two bridge replacement projects were added to the 1986-1988 Indiana Department of Highways Biennial Highway Improvement Program:

- 1. US 41, bridge replacement over the Little Calumet River, 0.5 mile South of I-80
- 2. I-80, replace the pipe arch culverts with precast box culverts on Grant Street, just South of the I-80/94 interchange in Gary.

The combined construction cost for the above listed projects is \$2,875,000 and contingent upon the availability of both state and federal funding, the projects are tentatively scheduled for construction in 1988 (Grant Street) and 1993 (US 41).
